

VACUUMING YOUR POOL

- Set your multi-port to FILTER and turn your filter system “ON”.
- Attach the vacuum head to the pole.
- Attach the rotating end of the vacuum hose to the vacuum head.
- Put the vacuum into the pool making sure the pole is secure.
- Take the other end of the hose and fill it with water utilizing the return. Allow it to fill until the bubbles subside to maximize the water pressure for an ease in vacuuming.
- Place the vacuum plate over the skimmer basket.
- Attach the hose to the vacuum plate, and be sure not to let any air in as you transfer the hose from the return to the vacuum plate.
- You are now all set to begin vacuuming.
- When you are finished with vacuuming, you are now ready to BACKWASH.

BACKWASHING AND RINSING PROCESSES

- You can only change the settings on the multi-port when the filter is “OFF”. The dial should be turned to BACKWASH, and the filter can be turned on again at that point.
- The backwash process takes anywhere from 15 seconds to 1 minute. You will know the filter has been backwashed properly when the sight glass becomes clear again.
- After the BACKWASH cycle is finished, you then do the same on RINSE. Rinsing usually takes about half the time that the BACKWASH does. Again you are waiting for the sight glass to rinse clean of all of the particles and be clear.
- When the BACKWASH and RINSE cycles are complete, it is now safe to turn the filter system “OFF” and turn the dial back to the FILTER.

CLEANING THE SKIMMER AND PUMP BASKETS

- Cleaning the skimmer basket is merely taking the basket out of the housing and shaking it out to remove all of the particles and debris that have been collected.
- The pump basket isn't as easy to access. You must turn the filter “OFF”, and place the multi-port on “TEST”. This will stop the water from coming out of the housing. Once that is done you can remove the cap and clean off the basket that sits inside the housing.
- The basket may need to be hosed off, but when you are finished simply replace the basket and put the cover back on. Then turn the multi-port back to “FILTER”. You are now ready to enjoy the fruits of your labor.
